The BECC believes in offering education to children that it can truly support. Children with physical differences can find the campus very challenging and there is currently no provision of supported bathrooms. With this in mind, any children that join the school with a physical SEN require their own support worker. The school works alongside the support worker to collaboratively design and implement an individual education Plan (IEP).

On occasions children may progress through the school and a SEN may arise later in their school life. When this is noted by the class teacher a record is created of any issues or support required. A meeting is held with the family and a recommendation for assessment to an appropriate party will be made.

The school will continue to work closely with the family to ensure that the best support can be offered and recommendations made as and when appropriate.
