The BECC believes that a uniform gives the children and staff a sense of belonging and unity. The children wear the uniform with pride and the uniform is appropriate to the location of the school. Students from Early Years to Year 6 are expected to wear uniforms.

Uniform 1



This uniform can be worn on any day unless PE is timetabled.

Uniform 2



This is the sports uniform and it can be worn any day of the week.

Hats

The BECC also maintains that children should always wear hats when outside. If a child forgets a hat they are reminded to bring one in the next day and there are spare hats available for the children to wear. A hat is provided to each student when they join the school along with a water bottle and available to purchase in the school office although they can replace with designs of their own choosing.

Water Bottles/ Shoes and Bags

Children should bring with them a water bottle and bag every day however water bottles, shoes and bags can be any sensible style of the students choosing.

Sports Teams

The BECC currently has a football team that requires a uniform. The cost of this uniform is 300 baht.

Staff Uniforms

All staff are given 3 school shirts to wear. For teaching positions and office staff the shirts are optional to wear as and when you choose. For Support Assistants, Nursery Assistants, cooks and housekeepers the shirts must be worn daily. The shirts should be worn with smart, black trousers or skirt. Each year the colour and design change slightly and vary between sports shirt and polo shirts.



All staff should look smart at all times and represent the school at all times to ensure a professional outlook. Sports clothes may be worn on sports days but smart casual and no jeans at all other times.
