

Homework Policy

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At The BECC we believe in giving our students the very best start to their education. Children study in different ways and we believe the most effective way for students to study is to also have downtime. Homework, whilst it will be set as and when required to support classwork is kept to a minimum.

All students from Reception to Year 6 have accounts for both Mathletics and Reading Eggs. It is the parents' choice how much time the students spend on these programmes however the school recommends around 10 to 15 minutes per day per application.

If parent's wish to further homework, supporting in class topics and completing further research and development work can be completed.

Students take home a reading book each week that should be read at home to a member of the family.
